End of the school day

We appreciate that the end of the school day can be a busy time and particularly now we have returned to our 3.15pm finishing time. Please can we remind parents/carers to be respectful of each other when collecting children. Please avoid blocking the pathway for others passing and wait away from your child's class doorway so all adults can be seen meaning children can be dismissed quickly and safely to those waiting.

PE

Please see below for class PE days. Children should come to school wearing PE kit on their PE day as this saves much learning time by not having to change before and after the lesson. Please take note of whether PE is indoors or out. During colder weather, children should wear tracksuit bottoms over their shorts for breaktimes/lunchtimes then remove them for their indoor PE session. Children will decide if they are needed for outdoors.

I appreciate that some families have purchase PE bags which will not be needed for bringing kits to school however, these can still be used to put any layers removed in prior to PE. A PE bag is not required if you do not already have one.
