KEY LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

In History this half term we will be learning about the Tudors. We will find out about The Battle of Bosworth and the different Tudor monarchs. We will focus our learning on Henry VIII and his impacts on the country.


In Science, we are continuing our learning about the three states of matter: solids, liquids and gases. The children will be learning about how temperature can cause a change in the state of matter.

In DT we will be creating and using nets. We will each create and decorate our own Christmas gift boxes.

We have enjoyed beginning to learn Spanish this half term! We have already learnt how to greet others, ask how they are and find out their name and age. We will now be learning about the days of the week and the seasons.

MATHS

In both Year 3 and 4 the main focus for this half term is multiplication and division. Children will begin by learning the appropriate times table facts and associated division sentences for their year group. They will then learn written methods for calculating more challenging multiplication and division problems.

WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME

One of the best ways to support your child at home is to listen to your child read daily and record this in their reading records. Discuss the characters and main events in the story to check their understanding of what they have read. Discuss the vocabulary and make predictions about what might happen next.

Encourage your child to use TT Rockstars to practise their times tables.

Help your child to learn their weekly spellings and to complete their homework. These will be given out every Friday. Homework will be due the following Friday. Children will also be given a school reading book each Friday. These must be returned to school once read so children can get a new book.


OUR READING TEXTS

The children will be learning to read fluently and with expression. They will focus on answering different style retrieval questions and using what they have read to make inferences about characters feelings.

Each class is also reading different books as our class novels. These are stories that are read aloud to the children for the children to enjoy.
