KEY LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

This half term in Geography, we will be learning about the country Brazil and drawing comparisons between Brazil and the United Kingdom. We will be thinking about how the location, climate and land use differ in each country.

As part of our Brazil topic, we are looking forwards to taking part in a carnival dance workshop during the first week back.

In Science, we will be studying animals, including humans. We will look at the food groups and what makes a healthy meal. We will also learn about the importance of the bones and muscles within our bodies and comparing these to the bodies of other animals.

Our DT will be about levers and linkages. We will use different types of levers to create images with moving parts.

WRITING

Our Writing this half term will be linked with our

Geography learning.
We will begin by retelling the fantastic story 'The Great
Kapok Tree' by Lynne Cherry,
which raises the issue of
deforestation in the Amazon
Rainforest.

Later in the term, we will be showcasing our learning about Brazil by writing a non-chronological report about the country.

MATHS

In both Year 3 and 4 the main focus for this half term is fractions. We will learn about unit and non-unit fractions and compare these. We will also look at equivalent fractions, using bar models to help us understand these.

Year 4 will move on to understand the difference between proper and improper fractions and convert between these.

We follow the White Rose maths curriculum.
